



JIM LAKE COMPANIES' MEMORIAL TO FALLEN OFFICERS, 'DALLAS CIRCLE OF HEROES' IS UNVEILED ON JULY 6TH

The horrific attack on police officers in downtown Dallas on July 7, 2016 was a sleepless night for Jim Lake Companies' partner Mike Morgan. Already in the midst of re-landscaping the Design District property where Jim Lake Companies has their office, he began visualizing a memorial.

In the spot of land directly on the Trinity Strand Trail, plans quickly shifted into a memorial for the five fallen officers. A flag pole bearing the Dallas and American flags is surrounded in a circle by six stones and five benches. Each of the officers has a plaque with their name and biography, and a sixth dedication stone describes the event and the intense meaning of each man's sacrifice.

Working closely with Assistant Chief Christina Smith of the Dallas Police Department and Chief Ed Addison of the DART Police

Department, the memorial came together with the blessing of each man's family, and an unveiling was planned.

On July 6, 2017, one day shy of the anniversary of the attacks, dozens of attendees from the City of Dallas, the Dallas and DART Police Departments, Dallas citizens, the officers' families, and news reporters gathered together to unveil the memorial to the public for the first time. The Dallas Honor Guard and Police Choir were part of the ceremony, as well as words from Jim Lake, Interim Dallas Police Chief Pughes, and DART Chief Spillers. Deputy Chief Albert Martinez served as the Master of Ceremony and Senior Corporal Mark Lang performed Taps following an emotional flag presentation. The unveiling was one of the first events of a weekend spent honoring the fallen officers.
